How can a nurse deliver effective and compassionate health care to people who use drugs? **Bevel Up** follows a team of street nurses as they reach out to youth, sex workers, and street-entrenched men and women in the alleys and hotels of Vancouver's inner city. Most importantly, the nurses reflect on attitudes they bring to their work – attitudes that can make or break the relationship needed to successfully provide practical and nonjudgmental health care.

Produced by the Street Nurse Program of the BC Centre for Disease Control, **Bevel Up** is designed to help student nurses and seasoned professionals working with drug-using populations.

A groundbreaking interactive DVD, **Bevel Up** offers dynamic and different ways to learn from over four hours of street scenes and expert interviews. Instructor and student can mix and match the following:

THE DOCUMENTARY (45 mins) Compelling on-location footage follows a team of experienced outreach nurses as they bring health care directly to the streets and to their clients.

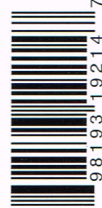
CHAPTERS (WITH TEACHING MENUS) **Bevel Up** can also be viewed in eight chapters. At the end of each chapter there's a dedicated menu that includes *Reflections on Practice* and *+Topics*.

REFLECTIONS ON PRACTICE Interviews with nurses who are featured in the chapter, plus a nursing ethicist and a nursing practice consultant.

+TOPICS Twenty-six interviews with leading experts on relevant subjects such as Drugs and the Brain, Pregnancy, Mental Health, Prohibition and Sex Work.

Bevel Up also comes with a **TEACHER'S GUIDE** outlining learning activities, discussion points and additional resources to augment each chapter.
